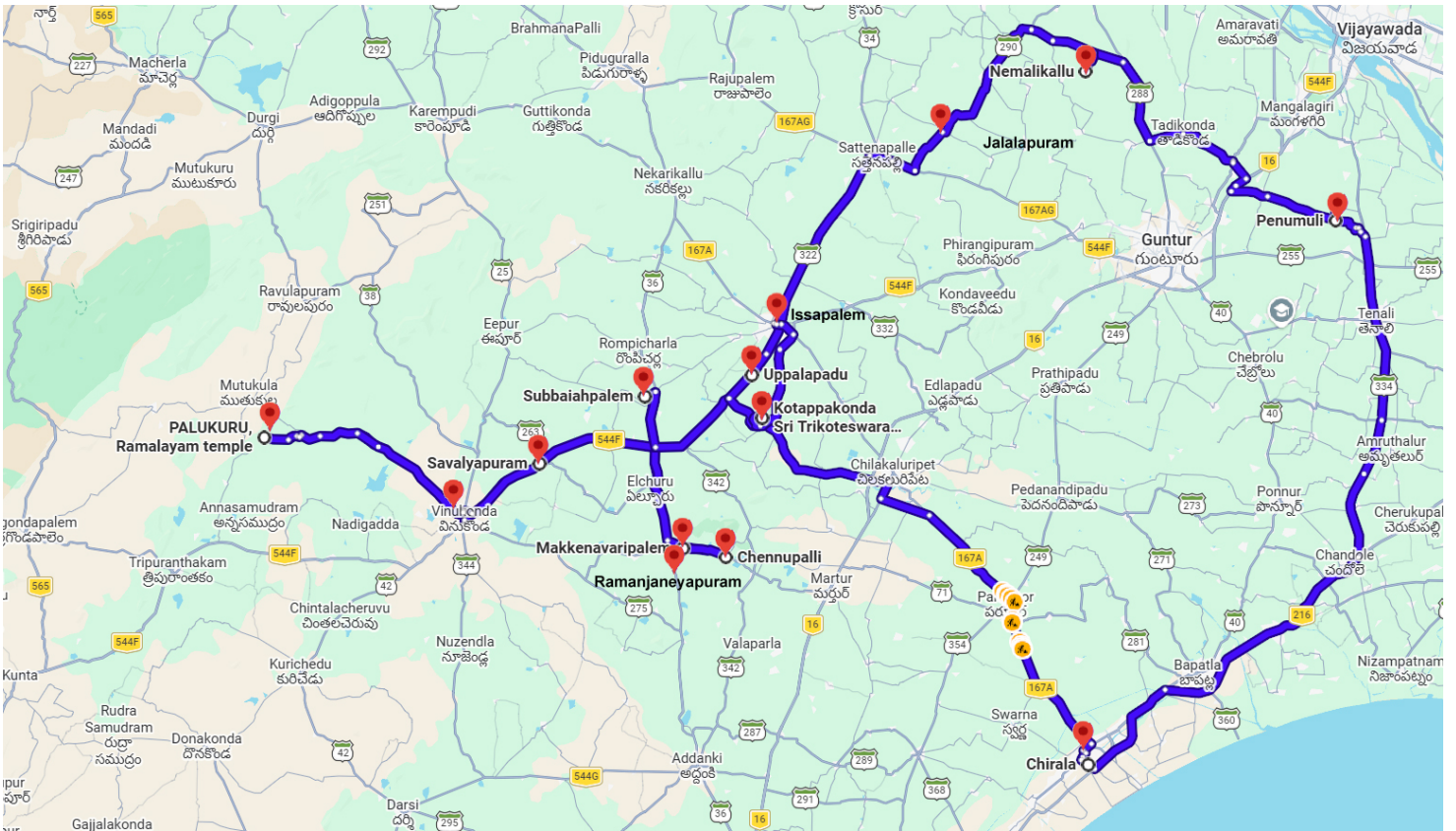


In many area houses are flooded and few are collapsed in our area, One of Indian Christian School Compound wall which is having 12 feet high got cracks on the walls, it is slowly leaning and got cracks on the ground in few days it may collapse, at that place the transformer and electricity poles are also bent and need to replace the front wall before it has collapsed, Please pray for the wall to rebuild. Amen

Due to Cyclone Compound-Wall, Transformer pole and Electricity poles are leaned due to Strong winds.



We travelled to different places to deliver the Gospel to known and unknown.



The current status of operations at ICS:

1) We have 265 kids attending in June as we starting the 2025-2026 year
Our total teaching and non-teaching staff are 26.
50 orphan poor kids are staying with us in the school.
Classes are provided from kindergarten to 10th grade.

2) We have a total of 50 kids in the home sir, in these there are 15 girls aged from 9 to 14 and 35 boys aged from 10 years to 15 years.
All these children are staying in the school where they are looked after by my family

Prayer Request and Requesting help for the following needs for 2026-2027 year

1. While we have been able to start this year's session due to the generosity of our brethren, we will need significant additional funds to continue operating the school at this level. We are currently collecting about \$1400 per month in tuition fees from the parents of our students, but our costs for running the school are roughly \$10,000 per month.
2. Need to restart two more buses and take the fitness certifications and do the needed repairs for the buses which will cost around \$17,300.
3. Needed help to construct the Subbaiahpalem church of Christ building to replace the building that was confiscated by the local government.
4. We have started many small congregations in the nearby villages over the years that need your prayers and financial help if possible. These villages are very poor and there are many sick and aged people needing help to survive. Many are new Christians. Some

have local preachers who need your prayers and support. Most worship outside under tents or in alleys because they have no secured place to meet.

5. We need to make some repairs on Indian Christian School building. We have successfully repaired the roof and drainage issues after last year's cyclone, but we still need to repair part of the compound wall and front compound at the place of transformer that collapsed in that storm. The roof drainage needs attention and the compound wall that collapsed during the cyclone need to be rebuilt. When possible, we also need to repair the air condition units damaged by the vandalism last year when the wires and copper tubing was stolen. Please help if you can.

PLEASE PRAY FOR THE CHALLENGES WE ARE FACING FROM THE LOCAL HIGH LEADERS WHO MADE LAWS. PRAY FOR THE CHANGE OF THEIR HEARTS AND OUR STRENGTH.

We appreciate and heartily welcome your prayers and financial assistance to continue the Lord's work with us in India. Any gift, no matter how small, would be a great blessing to us as we try to continue His Work to teach the poor children and orphans in India so they can read the Bible for themselves and raise their families up from poverty and illiteracy.
